the production of authenticity.... how can the 'House of Architecture' strengthen the RIBA's conservation skills agenda?

authenticity Greek 'authentikos' - 'to master'

of undisputed origin and not a copy; genuine..... AND made or done in the traditional or original way, or in a way that faithfully resembles an original.

.....so authenticity is both a material, historic reality, and a convincing contemporary facsimile?

.....are we skilled in keeping – or copying?

actually it is both.....

authenticity

sympathetic repair is at one end of the authenticity spectrum, designing new fire stations with pediments at the other....

understanding how and where to deploy our conservation skills is as important as the skills themselves.....

.....so-called practical decisions are never neutral, innocent or value-free.....the act of 'conservation' creates an ethical benchmark that defines how we engage with people, source or specify material and communicate significance so that others understand a history and their role in its production.
